Saturday June 10th

The Shrine of St. Augustine of Canterbury, Ramsgate- designed by Augustine Welby Pugin- is the setting for this year's day pilgrimage for the Kent Area Ordinariate. The plan is to gather for Mass on arrival and enjoy a shared lunch (provided at nominal cost). After lunch there will be time for a walk along the coast or visitors can enjoy a guided tour. The pilgrimage will end with a veneration of the relics of St. Augustine. The Shrine recalls England's great missionary St Augustine of Canterbury, who landed near to the Shrine.

We have booked a coach for this day. It will pick pilgrims up from St. Anselm's at 9:30am and we aim to arrive home around 6pm. The subsidised cost for the return journey is £10 per adult pilgrim and £5 per child.
